

Elementary Programs:

LEAP is a special education program designed to serve students in 1st through 5th grade who are identified with an emotional behavioral disability and are experiencing significant emotional and/or behavioral challenges and who have not been successful in their home school despite numerous and varied interventions. 3 locations housed in Marquette, Olson, and Randall Elementary School buildings.

Primary Steps can provide up to a full day of services to students with educational disabilities and co-occurring mental health challenges who are in first through fifth grade. Steps is a partnership between Madison Metropolitan School District (MMSD) and Family Service of Madison (FSM). IIP's Steps Program focuses on teaching skills for managing emotions and coping with stress in addition to academic core instruction. Steps is an off-site community based program.
